Southeast Louisiana Flood Protection Authority – West (SLFPA-W) Technical, Operations, and Maintenance Committee Meeting Tuesday, December 8, 2015

The Technical, Operations, and Maintenance (TOM) Committee of the SLFPA – W met on Tuesday, December 8, 2015 with the following members present: Mr. Gaddy, chairman, and Mr. Wilkinson. Mr. Julien was absent. Also in attendance were: Mr. Monzon, Mr. Noel, Ms. Noll, and Mr. Roark.

The Committee briefly discussed the building renovation/architect status.

Mr. Monzon and Mr. Noel reviewed the fuel management system. The Committee requested that the detailed productivity benefits provided during the meeting be attached to the AFE submittal for completeness.

Mr. Monzon presented the draft auction agreement with Henderson Auction and related escrow agreement.

Mr. Noel updated the Committee with information regarding a NOAA hardened weather station. The Committee requested staff conduct some additional research and report back.

Mr. Monzon provided a Director's report of activities for the month of December and informed the Committee on pending issues.
