The Finance, Administration, Legal and Public Information (FALPI) Committee of the SLFPA-W met on Tuesday, April 14, 2020, with the following members participating in person: Mr. Gauthé, Chairman, Mr. Burke; and by teleconference: Mr. Gaddy.

Mr. Gauthé called the meeting to order in the Commissioners' meeting room at the SLFPA-W Office, 7001 River Road, Marrero, Louisiana at approximately 3:30 P.M.

It was moved by Mr. Burke and seconded by Mr. Gaddy to approve the agenda as presented.

There were no public comments.

It was moved by Mr. Burke and seconded by Mr. Gaddy to approve the minutes from the previous meeting dated March 10, 2020.
